## Happy Anniversary, St. Dominic Parish

## Dear Parishioners,

Ninety years ago, St. Dominic parish was celebrating Easter for the first time. On October 29, 1933, the Feast of Christ the King, parishioners of the newly formed St. Dominic parish gathered at the Mutual Aid Hall at the corner of Delhi and Greenwell, to celebrate the Mass with Fr. Aloysius Grimmelsman, the first pastor. That event marked the beginning of St. Dominic Parish. That was ninety years ago. One year later, in September 1934, St. Dominic School opened with ninety-three students taught by three Sisters of Charity.
Of course, it all started much earlier than ninety years ago. It started with God's graciousness. It started when God graciously chose to create the universe and humankind. It continued when God so loved us that God chose to give us eternal life through the Passion, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. It continued when God sent the Holy Spirit upon the first followers of Jesus and invited them to be part of His mission to bring God's love to the world. It continues as God graciously sends the Holy Spirit upon us and invites us to do the same.
For ninety years, St. Dominic parishioners have lived in the awareness of God's graciousness. God's graciousness and blessings have filled our hearts with gratitude, and we have gathered every weekend for ninety years to give thanks to God in the celebration of the Eucharist. For ninety years, grateful St. Dominic parishioners have tried to bring Christ's love and values to the Delhi community. For ninety years, St. Dominic parishioners have passed on their faith from generation to generation.
Through these years, our parish has seen additions to our school, new ministries, and the building of our beautiful church, parish center and gathering place. But what we are most proud of is our growth in faith from one generation to the next. Over the years, parishioners have watched their grandchildren graduate from our school, serve Mass as they did, compete on our athletic teams, and grow into loving adults. For ninety years, our parish has truly been a community of "Generations Growing in Faith!"

Order forms are available in the racks at the doors of church, or you can download a form from the parish website by clicking on Ministries/General Parish Ministries/Gathering Place Walkway. Bricks and Pavers can also be ordered online by going to our website and clicking on the green "Online Giving" button on the left hand side, scroll until you find Gathering Place Walkway. You can also stop in the Parish Office to order a paver.
The $4 \times 8$ bricks allow 3 lines with 13 characters per line and cost $\$ 40.00$.
The $8 \times 8$ pavers allow up to 6 lines with 13 characters per line and cost \$75.00.
