Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

Each summer, the Mission Office of the Archdiocese invites a missionary group to share their mission work in all the parishes. Next weekend, August 7-8, we will have a guest speaker at all the Masses offering the annual mission appeal. Foundation for Children in Need is a Catholic lay organization based in Arlington Heights, IL. Mr. Tom Chitta, Co-Founder of FCN is very happy to visit us and share information about their mission work in the interior villages of India. FCN sponsors 2,000 children and college students. They have been responsible for building several schools, boarding homes, a community health center and two homes for the elderly. 1,500 children born with cleft lip and cleft palate have been helped with free corrective surgeries in the past 7 years. Instruction in PSR is offered during the school year, September-May, for children in grades 1-8. Classes meet Sunday mornings at 10:30 a.m. for all grade levels. There is special emphasis on the Sacramental years, usually 2nd, 7th and 8th grades, with added activities for parents and candidates.
