FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Recollections of the summer of 2000 continued!

What is the proper response to the coercive, abusive, use of power? That is a question I struggled with intellectually



in the summer of 2000! It was clear to me that if I knew the authority was abusing power and commanding me to go against the ten commandments or to do something seriously immoral, I would have to publicly denounce the one in authority and refuse to obey. But what about the authority assigning me to a parish and my promise of obedience? I judged that the archbishop was abusing his power by not acting in a participatory manner, and "lording it over" me. Was my obedience being codependent to the archbishop's need to control and exert power over me?

I came to the conclusion that it is appropriate to obey when there are values at stake that supersede the perceived dysfunction, or values that supersede the value of refusing to obey! There was such a value for me in the summer of 2000! It was my belief that God was present and active amongst the people of St. Dominic! It was my growing realization that, despite the dysfunction of the process, God was calling me to serve that movement of God as priest and pastor of St. Dominic! With God's help I was able to be at peace with obeying and accepting the assignment!

PARKING FOR 7:30 A.M. MASSGOERS ON SCHOOL DAYS!

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

ST. DOMINIC-DELHI KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS




