The St. Dominic Adopt-A-Student Tuition Assistance Program has helped many families attend our exceptional school that may not have been able to afford the full cost of tuition. We have set our tuition rate for the 2021-2022 school year at \$3,400.00, net of any parish investment, etc. As in the past, we welcome any monetary gift to the program; however, we have established gift levels as described below for those that wish to sponsor a student:

Gold Level Gift of \$2,550.00	Sponsors a student for ¾ of the school year
Silver Level Gift of \$1,700.00	Sponsors a student for ½ of the school year
Bronze Level Gift of \$850.00	Sponsors a student for ¼ of the school year
