#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The weekend of October 7/8, twenty years ago, I celebrated my first Mass at St. Dominic and preached at all the Masses. I introduced myself and thanked those I had already met for

God is in our midst, loving us, challenging us, and inspiring us. I have already experienced it! In your welcoming me, I have recognized God loving me. Telling me it is going to be alright. I said good-bye to friends in Washington. God will give me new ones! In your acceptance and trust of me without knowing me, I have recognized God inspiring me to be worthy of that trust."

As I look back on this first week and today, I have recognized your welcome of me as God's way of loving me! My prayer is that at some time you will be able to look upon my coming to St. Dominic as God's way of loving you!
