Every Saturday, 8:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., or by appointment.

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

Communion for the Sick and Homebound

VOTIVE LIGHTS

Envelopes for requesting a Votive Light are on the Communion railing near the Blessed Virgin Altar and close to the door as you exit by the Infant of Prague statue. On the envelope, you can designate an intention. The usual donation is \$2.00 to cover the cost of the candle. Candles are lit on Thursday for the week. 


