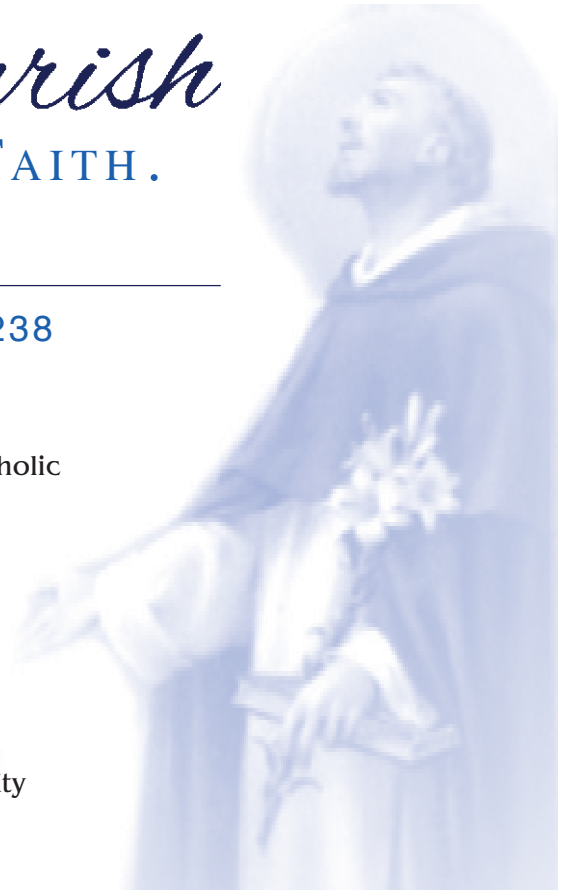

**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Labor for the things that last.

If you travel through Ireland, you will be struck at the tremendous number of ruined churches, monasteries, and castles dotted throughout the country. They are a reminder of the fact that the Church has been in Ireland since the fifth century and possibly even earlier. The ruins are a sign that the Light of Christ and the Christian message took root, flourished, and grew in Ireland. They are also a sign that over time, the Church suffered much and was ravished, hunted, and decimated. Her abbeys, monasteries, churches, and schools all disappeared, but the faith lived on. What began as a few Christians, a small flickering light, is still present even today. What was essential for the faith wasn't the buildings, but the people.

As we celebrate Labor Day, I want to thank all those, who over many generations, many years, and many changes and challenges, have worked hard to build the Kingdom of God here at Our Lady of Victory, St. Dominic, St. Simon the Apostle, St. Vincent de Paul, and St. Al's on the Ohio. One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

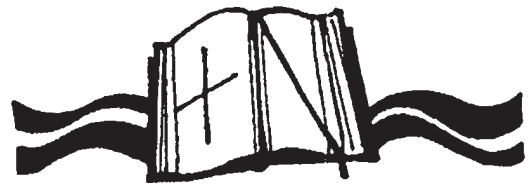

SafeParish is the child protection platform for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. All new volunteers should follow the SafeParish registration instructions for creating a SafeParish account. You can find a copy of the SafeParish registration instructions and a link to SafeParish on our website at [www.stdominicdelhi.org](http://www.stdominicdelhi.org). Click on the SafeParish button on the left side of the page.

During the registration process, new volunteers will be invited to complete their background check and child protection training online. The \$25.00 fee for this can be paid by credit card or with a "token." Contact the parish ministry for which you volunteer to get information on obtaining a token for payment. For any questions concerning SafeParish, please go to the Archdiocese of Cincinnati Safe Environment webpage at <https://catholicaoc.org/offices/safe-environment>.

**Weekly Emails** – Each Tuesday, SafeParish sends an email regarding the updated child protection and workplace safety articles that are posted on the SafeParish website. These articles are NOT required, but are recommended reading.

**Quarterly Bulletins** – Everyone registered with SafeParish receives a quarterly training video. The training bulletin **must** be completed in 30 days to remain active and in compliance with the Archdiocese of Cincinnati Child Protection Policy.

An In Compliance list is posted to the St. Dominic Parish website on the 15th of each month. No one may work with children if they are not active and in compliance. If you did not get the bulletin, check your spam or junk mail. You can also sign into your account, go to the Training tab and click on the "Due" link to see which bulletins are due and their due date.
