#### ANOTHER WAY TO SUPPORT ST. DOMINIC

The IRS raised the age for Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) to age 72. However, you may still make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from your IRA account as long as you are at least age 72. If you are required to make an RMD, QCDs will satisfy your annual distribution requirement and will not be included in your taxable income for the year. This could be a great way to save taxes and financially support St. Dominic Parish. **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR** The application process for applying for financial assistance for the 2023-2024 school year is now open. If you have a high school student next year, and you have applied for assistance through FACTS, you do not have to complete the application for your St. Dominic student, as long as you have selected St. Dominic as one of your schools. PLEASE MAKE CERTAIN YOU HAVE SELECTED ST. DOMINIC AS ONE OF YOUR SCHOOLS.

To begin the application process, go to: www.factsmgt.com. In the upper left corner of the page, click on "Parent Log In." If you applied for assistance last year (2022-2023), your login credentials will be the same. If you are utilizing FACTS for tuition payment processing for this current school year, your login credentials are the same. Click on the link, "Apply for Financial Aid." The instructions for completing the application are relatively intuitive. However, if you experience any issues, please contact FACTS at 866-412-4637.

Awards will first be granted through the Catholic Education Foundation (the Archdiocese of Cincinnati's <u>One Faith, One</u> <u>Hope, One Love</u> campaign). CEF awards will be announced in February, 2023. St. Dominic will announce Parish awards in the Spring of 2023. **The deadline to apply for assistance is February 3, 2023 for CEF and St. Dominic Parish Awards. No exceptions can be made!** You will need your 2021 tax return information. You will also have to upload pages one and two from your 2021 tax return as well as copies of any 2021 W-2s.

**ST. DOMINIC GIRLS SOFTBALL** – Girls' softball registration is open for grades PreK-8, and will remain open until Sunday, February 5 for Pre-K-2nd grade and Sunday, January 22, for 3rd-8th grades.

Please take note of the registration close date.
