#### Children's Liturgy of the Word – CLOW

Have you ever been at 9:30 a.m. Mass on Sunday, when Father calls children up to go forth with an adult leader to hear the Word of God, and wonder what is going on? Well, this is Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW)

Children's Liturgy of the Word is a worship experience geared especially for children. The Word of God has a message that is as relevant and fitting for children as it is for adults. Liturgy of the Word with Children offers an experience for the children to hear Scripture in words they understand and to share their own understanding of God's Word.

What Happens? The celebration of the Liturgy of the Word with Children follows the same structure as the Liturgy of the Word for the entire assembly. The children celebrate the Introductory Rites with their families in the large assembly. After the opening prayer, the presider invites any children wishing to participate to join the leader, a trained catechist. The children and CLOW leaders proceed to the Gathering Place where they will hear and discuss the readings from the Children's Lectionary. The children return after the Prayer of the Faithful to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist with their families and the entire community. We welcome all the children to join us. Celebrating the Liturgy of the Word in this way is an empowering experience and we are so happy that we can offer this to our families. CLOW is held during the 9:30 a.m. Mass on Sunday at St. Dominic and is for children Pre-K through Third Grade. We will resume CLOW on October 6.

# A Perfect Christmas Gift

Christmas is coming soon! Consider purchasing a Gathering Place paver for the person in your life who is hard to shop for. Pavers are the gift that lets your mother, father, grandparent, child, or spouse know how cherished they are. Order forms are available at the doors of church or in the Parish Office. The 4 x 8 bricks allow three lines with 13 characters per line and cost \$40.00. The 8 x 8 pavers allow up to 6 lines with 13 characters per line and cost \$40.00. 
#### JR. HIGH YOUTH MINISTRY
